

Accreditations

Eligible professional/press activities

- **Film industry professionals:** distributor, exhibitor, broadcaster, sales agent, feature-length films and/or documentaries producer, festival programmer (if the festival is associated with American cinema)

An ID picture in jpg format and supporting professional documents will be required.

- **Journalists:** television, radio, Internet, print

An ID picture in jpg format, a copy of the press card, a letter from the editor in chief and a copy of any articles published in the past and details of media coverage will be required.

- **Photographers**

An ID picture in jpg format, a letter from the editor in chief of the agency and possibly past-published photos of the event will be required.

How to request an accreditation

Applications for accreditations for the 46th Deauville American Film Festival, taking place from September 4 to 13, 2020, must be done **online starting July 6th, 2020**.

Please enclose proof of professional occupation and an ID photograph as requested.

The applicant will be informed by e-mail as to the status of his application.

Deadline and accreditation fee

I Applications for accreditations must be sent online before **August 22, 2020** and issuance will be subject to availability.

Accreditation fee: 30€ per person (50€ per person after the deadline).

When a request is validated, the applicant is notified by e-mail, and will be requested to proceed to the accreditation's online payment.

If your request does not meet the requirements set out by the Festival, you can go online to purchase a PASS.

Accreditation collection

Accreditations can be collected in Deauville at the Accreditation Desks from **September 4, 2020**.

How to use your accreditation

Accreditations give access to all screening locations (C.I.D, Casino Cinema & Morny Club), all screenings within the limit of available seats, upon presentation of the accreditation, and are valid **during the whole duration of the Festival**.

Access to screenings ★

Professional/press accreditation holders have the possibility to purchase access cards to evening screenings ★ scheduled at the C.I.D., at the cost of 15€/screening.

Access cards to a screening ★ can be purchased and collected the same day, before 7pm, at the Festival ticket office (“billetterie”).

Access to screening ★ without an access card remains possible, with no guarantee and within the limit of available seats, for professional/press accreditation holders. Access: **Accès BLEU** (Blue access) | **boulevard Cornuché - facing the Casino**, upon presentation of the accreditation.
